

VIEW OF THE EARLY CHRISTIANS

- Identity of the Man of Sin
 - Future Antichrist
 - He is a person who opposes God
 - He acts in the place God
 - Little horn (Dan 7) and harlot (Rev 17)
 - He will persecute God's people for 3.5 times/years
- Identity of the restraining power
 - The Roman Empire
- The time of the Man of Sin
- Has full authority over the church after the fall of the Roman Empire for 1260 days



EARLY CHRISTIAN VIEWS ABOUT DANIEL 7

- **•The expectations of the early Christians**
 - •The 4 beasts are the empires of Babylon, Medo-
 - Persia, Greece, and Rome
 - Rome would be divided into 10 kingdoms
 - **•**Afterward the little horn power, the Antichrist,
 - would arise, uproot 3 kingdoms, and last till the end of the world
 - The little horn dominates God's people for "a time, and times, and half a time"
 - to change times and laws.

RISE OF THE MAN OF SIN


- Nature of the apostasy and its persecution
 - In the 4th century Emperor Constantine favored the Catholic body of Christians which became the most powerful group of Christians
- Major changes in the 6th century—Unity of Church State
 - Emperor Justinian I makes the pope head of all churches of Christendom and the corrector of heretics.
 - Catholicism: Salvation is obtained through works and the clergy
 - Union of Church and State led to expansion of Catholicism through armies
 - Growing persecution of those who question the Catholic church



RISE OF PROTEST IN THE MIDDLE ÅGES

- The Waldenses and Albigenses
 - they were persecute by the Inquisition
 - They identified the Little Horn as a system— the Papacy
 - Similarly the Papacy was identified as the man of sin, Babylon, and antichrist

 Protest against the RCC disregard of the Bible teachings and practices had great impact until





VIEWS OF THE WALDENSES

- The RCC is harlot and Babylon of Revelation
- It is the antichrist, sitting in God's temple (church)
- It attacks the truth and the saints
- The pope is head and originator of all heresies
- Preaching authority is from God, not from bishop or pope
- God's elect is still in Babylon. Call to come out of Babylon
- Waldenses are the true representatives of the apostles



FURTHER LIGHT ON PROPHETIC TIME IN THE MIDDLE ÅGES

- **Prophetic views since the 12th** century. Prophetic time is not literal but symbolic according to the RC Abbot Joachim of Floris
 - He applied the year-day principle in Num 14 and Ezek 4 to the time prophecies about the antichrist in **Daniel and Revelation**
 - **Context: After many centuries Rome had taken on the** characteristics of the antichrist in the Bible prophecy



DEVELOPMENTS OF TIME PROPHECY IN THE MIDDLE ÅGES

•Impact of Joachim of Fiori since 12th c. Prophetic time is seen symbolic **•Use of the year-day principle of Num** 14:34 and Ezek 4:6 •The 3 1/2 times/years or 42 months or 1260 days equals 1260 actual years. **•1260 years begins with Christ's birth** •It ends with A.D. 1260 Beginning: Christ's death in 31 •Ending: 31+1260=1291 Beginning: Jerusalem's Fall in 70 **•Ending: 70+1260=1330**





FURTHER LIGHT ON THE LITTLE HORN **OF DANIEL 7 IN THE MIDDLE ÅGES**

- Context: Power struggle between Pope Gregory **IX and the Emperor Fredrick II**
- Place: Synod of Regensberg, **Germany** (1240)
- Event: The defense of the emperor by Eberhard II, Archbishop of Salzburg (1200–1246)
- Eberhard's new insight:
 - The Pope is the little horn of Daniel 7
 - Key issue: Did Rome fall in the time of the the early church that led to the rise of the little horn?





IN THE 13TH CENTURY EVIDENCE **BECAME CLEAR THAT ROME HAD FALLEN** Archbishop Eberhard's contribution

- - Historical facts confirm that Rome had fallen and was divided into 10 kingdoms
 - Rise of the little horn fits the history of the papacy
 - Nature of the little horn reveals the nature of the papacy
- Eberhard's impact: Papacy as the little horn of Daniel 7 becomes the standard view among
 - John Wycliffe and his followers in Britain
 - Luther and his associates in Germany
 - Cranmer and Knox and the majority of British Reformers
 - The majority of the 17th and 18th century Protestants

VIEW OF MANY PROTESTANT REFORMERS

- Identity of the Man of sin—the antichrist

 - Rise of the apostate church— Papacy • New insight in prophetic time: A day is one year. Papacy was to rule for 3.5 years or 42 months or 1260 days. This is 1260 years • Papacy is the little horn of Dan 7, who persecutes God's people for 3.5 "prophetic" years or 1260 years In Rev 12 Satan persecutes God's people for 1260 prophetic days or 1260 years • In Rev 13, Satan's instrument is the 1st beast of Rev 13. It is the papacy that persecutes God's people for 42 prophetic months or 1260 years

 - Papacy is the harlot of Revelation 17

THE REFORMERS, THE WOMAN AND THE DRAGON OF REVELATION 12

- The war between the woman and the dragon
 - Satan working through the Roman Empire attacks God's people to destroy Christ
 - Christ escapes and Satan continues to persecute the church for 1260 prophetic days or 1260 years
 - After this time Satan launches an attack on the remnant of God's people who are faithful




THE REFORMERS AND THE SEA BEAST OF REVELATION 13

- Rise of 1st beast of Revelation 13
 - The beast rises out of the sea and is composed of elements of the empires of Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, and Rome.
 - Dragon gives the beast his power, throne and authority for 42 prophetic months or 1260 years.
 - The beast was worshiped, it blasphemed, one of its heads was mortally wounded and it was healed.




HERITAGE OF PROTESTANT CHRISTIANITY

•Views of the Little Horn's rule during the Reformation
•Beginning: Emperor Constantine in 312
•Ending: 312+1260=1572
•Pope Leo I in 440. Ending 440+1260=1700



- What was their source of information? • The Bible
 - Prophecy studied in the light of history-**Prophetic history**
 - Study of Daniel and the Revelation





RC CHURCH LAUNCHED THE COUNTER REFORMATION Strategy to eliminate Protestantism

- Formation of the Jesuit order
 - They developed a counter interpretation of prophecy
- Focus of the attack: The year-day principle
 - It is not Biblical
 - It is against the ancient traditions of the church
- - Futurism and Preterism



• It gives unreliable time calculations for the antichrist

 Method: Introduction of 2 conflicting approaches to divert the identification of antichrist with the papacy



JESUIT PROPHETIC COUNTER INTERPRETATIONS

- Rise of Modern Futurism
- Francisco de Ribera (1537-1591)
 - Focus: Identification of the antichrist in Daniel
 - Sources: The early church fathers
 - View: Antichrist is a person, not a system who rules in the final 7 years of the world
- **Bellarmine** (1542-1621)
 - Fall of Rome: It takes place in the future. **Rome is not yet divided**
 - Dual interpretation of the little horn: Little horn is Antiochus who is a type of antichrist. The true antichrist will appear in the future








JESUIT PROPHETIC COUNTER **INTERPRETATIONS**

- **Rise of Modern Preterism**
- Luis del Alcazar (1554-1613)
 - Focus: Identification of the antichrist in Revelation
- Content of Revelation
 - War of the Catholic Church on Jews and Pagans
 - Rev 1-11: Rejection of Jews, fall of Jerusalem
 - Rev 12-19: Overthrow of pagan Roman Empire
- Sources: The early church fathers
- View of antichrist
 - Antichrist has already appeared
 - Antichrist is not a system but Emperor Nero








JESUIT IMPACT ON PROTESTANTISM

- Short term effect on Protestants was minimal
 - Few Protestants accepted futurism or preterism
- Long term effect extensive (late 19th and 20th centuries)
 Futurism adopted by evangelicals and
 - Futurism adopted by evangelicationalists
 - Preterism adopted by historical critics
- After the Christian churches rejected the Great Second Advent Movement of the 1840s that was based on the Protestant historicist method of prophetic interpretation these Protestants accepted the futurist and preterist approaches of the counter reformation.
- Now only few historicists remain. The large majority now follows the RCC approach to prophecy, bringing Catholics and Protestants closer together in prophetic understanding.






RISE OF A NEW KIND OF PROTESTANTISM IN THE 17TH AND 18TH CENTURIES

- Focus on the writings of the Reformers, not the Bible
- Engaged in theological controversies
- Churches use government power to suppress views different than those of the Reformers
 Development of the cold orthology
- Development of the cold orthodoxy of Sardis. It appears to be alive, but it is dead. (Rev 3:1)
- Stagnation of the Protestant Reformation



JESUS STRATEGY FOR THE LAST DAYS

- The Protestant Reformation is to continue
 - "Jesus and all the heavenly host looked with disgust upon the scene; yet God had a message for the church that was sacred and important. If received, it would make a thorough reformation in the church, revive the living testimony that would purge out hypocrites and sinners, and bring the church again into favor with God." (Early Writings, p. 228)




JESUS REVIVES THE ARRESTED REFORMATION THROUGH PROPHETIC SIGNS AND FULFILLMENTS

- Jesus' strategy revealed in prophecy
 - Signs on earth (Lisbon earthquake 1755), in sun and moon (Dark Day 1780) and stars (Leonids 1833) (Rev 6)
 - The French Revolution (1789-1799) (Rev 11)
 - Deadly wound of the papacy in 1798 (Dan 7; Rev 13)
 - From 1798 on there began the unsealing of Daniel (12:4) that shifted the attention from the 1260 prophetic days of Daniel 7 to the 2300 prophetic days of Daniel 8.
- Result
 - The study of Dan 8:14 resulted in the rise of the Great Second Advent Movement of the 1830s and 1840s

• IX. To learn the true meaning of figures, trace your figurative word through your Bible, and, where you find it explained, put it on your figure, and if it makes good sense, you need look no further; if not, look again

 X. Figures sometimes have two or more different significations; as day is used in a figurative sense to represent three different periods of time. 1. Indefinite. 2. Definite, a day for a year. 3. Day for a thousand years. Eccles. vii. 14. Ezek. iv. 6. 2 Pet. iii. 8.

• XI. Parables are used as comparisons to illustrate subjects, and must be explained in the same way as figures, by the subject

• XII. To know whether we have the true historical event for the fulfillment of a prophecy. If you find every word of the prophecy (after the figures are understood) is literally fulfilled, then you may know that your history is the true event. But if one word lacks a fulfillment, then you must look for another event, or wait its future development. For God takes care that history and prophecy doth agree, so that the true, believing children of God may never be ashamed. Ps. xxi. 5. Isa xiv. 17-19. 1 Pet. ii. 6. Rev.




NOTE THE IMPACT OF THE PROTESTANT REFORMATION ON ADVENTISM

- Adventists inherited the Historical (Historicist) interpretation of prophecy from the Reformers
- They inherited the view that the papacy is the antichrist, the man of sin, and the little horn of Daniel 7 that arose out of the Roman Empire
- Adventists inherited the year-day principle used by the Reformers that interpreted the 2300 days as 2300 years when Christ was to cleanse the sanctuary in 1844
- The Adventists' commitment to the "Bible and the Bible Only" separated them from opposing Christians and shed new light on Christ final ministry in heaven which revealed the last message of mercy (Rev 14:6-12).






